• Application Procedure

1. Applicants should submit application form for student exchange program and learning agreement to **E11-4042** during the application period. *Postgraduate students please also submit the recommendation letter from your own supervisor*

2. Applicants will be given an interview and admission result will be notified through email.

3. The successful applicants will be nominated by FST and are asked to complete the application form with required documents for the host institution.

4. Please complete and submit the course exemption form to FST after your return to UM to earn your credits back.

- Credits earned count toward UM degree.

EXCHANGE PROGRAM OVERVIEW

- Expenses

- No tuition fee is paid in the partner university
 - but UM students continue to pay UM fees
- Students pay for accommodation
 - Partners help to find accommodation, but not guaranteed.
- Students pay all living expenses, insurance fee, visa fee and transportation fee

Type 3 — Special Recommended	Southeast University/ Chonbuk National University/ Polytechnique Montréal (GPA 3.0 or above)
Type 4 — Master Student Exchange	Good Academic Standing
